Apart from the maritime mails, of interest is that the Diesner estate also includes some nice United States cancellation mini-collections, such as County Postmarks (Indiana, Montana), Pacific Mail Services ("China Steam"), and cancellations of the United States Postal Agencies n China and Japan.

This year, the auctioneer's traditional "99 Crazy lots for Christmas" include Abraham Lincoln and Elvis Presley Autographs, the \$4 Black United States Wells Fargo issue, and rare Panama and British Guiana items.
