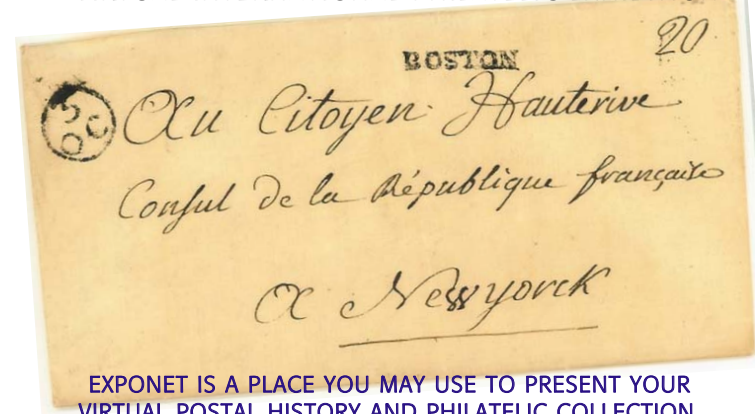

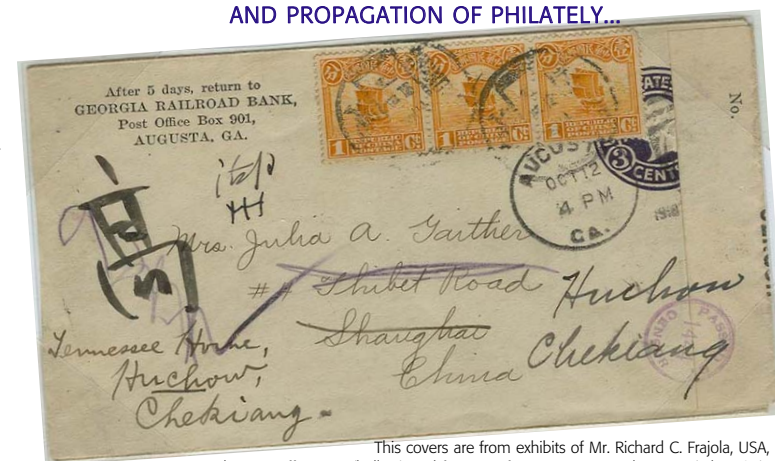
# EXPONET
