Type 1, instead of the sans-serif type fount as used in S.G. Type 2 and on S.G. 16 Neatly cancelled on small piece by light and largely complete MAFEKING C.G.H. dated April 1900, fine and attractive. With BPA Expertising Ltd. certificate (2004) This is one of the two copies noted on the Stanley Gibbons catalogue and the discovery of this item led to this mention."

This stamp was discovered in 2003 after having been submitted to BPA (England) Expertising Ltd. as a normal used copy of the 2/- on British Bechuanaland 1/-, **SG 16**. Following its discovery, it was decided to seek further opinions, and it was sent to two leading students in the field of '**Mafeking Siege Stamps**' and '**Boer War**' philately.

One of these specialists provided information of another copy, which was offered in **Cavendish Philatelic Auctions** (England) Sale No. 206, held in Leeds on the 4th of April 1970 as lot 314. It was offered as a normal **SG 16**, but was fortunately photographed in the catalogue. This copy is also postmarked April 1900.

The second consultant agreed it was genuine, but probably an essay. This could be correct as the British Bechuanaland 4d was surcharged 1/- with both **SG Type 1** and **SG Type 2** fonts as a surcharge double. This is a known practice of some jobbing printers of that era in deliberately overprinting a subject twice, with either different type or different inks. Then, one selects the font that is bolder or clearer to the eye. These 1/- on 4d doubles are listed as **SG 11ab**. The majority of the known examples of this item were discovered in the Baden-Powell family philatelic material, handled by the late Cyril Harmer, of H.R. Harmer Ltd., Bond Street, following the death of Lord Baden-Powell.

With the benefit of the information provided, and the co-operation of the two consultants which concurred with the opinion of their Committee, BPA Expertising Ltd. issued a certificate of genuineness for this item in 2004. As a consequence a note has been added to the Stanley Gibbons catalogue about the two recorded copies of this stamp.

Whether an essay that was subsequently issued and used, an error, or an overprint applied to a few copies at a different time to the majority of the **British Bechuanaland 1/-** stamps makes this an interesting item. That the two known copies are both used during the Siege period, being both used in April 1900, confirms they were there, and that they are part of the story of the Siege.
