The FDC of Colombia's 1st issue is the only First Issue FDC recorded from any country in the Americas, including Canada and the United States.

Included is a 'Missing Hologram' full sheet, the 'Missing Moose', and the 1998 'Christmas' perforation change matched Set-of-Plate No. Blocks. The Registration issues include Re-Entries and an impressive Precancel section is highlighted by an 'Amherst' on the $4 \not \subset$ 'Admiral'.

Nova Scotia features an unused Sc 1 and an exceptional 'Three Penny'. A very nice item is the Newfoundland 'Two Penny' scarlet-vermilion, being very fine with huge margins.

The auctioneer's 2008 edition of their annual Rarities of the World sale, a much anticipated philatelic fraternity 'happening'.

This year's sale offers exceptional United States covers from the Erin Gunter United States Postal History Estate, and from a 'Midwestern' United States Collection, the offerings including Louisiana usages, and desirable Confederate States.

A newly-discovered 5c 11847 5 $\$$ 'Wheeling Grid Pre-Cancel’ cover is offered to the market for the first time. Rare and superb stamps will be found throughout, including a Sc 9 graded 'Mint NH Gem $\mathbf{1 0 0} \mathbf{J u m b o}$ ' by PSE (the only unused stamp prior to Sc 212 to achieve the zenith of PSE Grades). Sc 5 (Pos. 7R1E) is represented by a single offered for the first time at auction, and two covers with strips containing this major rarity.

Inverted ERRORs include a Block-of-4 of the 1c Pan-American, a single 1c PSEgraded 'XF 90' and, remarkably, a 4c Pan-American Invert with a new PSE certificate also graded "XF 90' (the finest graded example).
