The China is replete with better items, to incl the Qing Dynasty 'Large' and 'Small Dragons' (incl a very nice mixed-franking cover), a large margin 'Large Dragon' unused set (with Certificates), the 1897 \$1 'Red Revenue' NH, and the 'Coiling Dragon' and 'Dowagers'.

The 1912-1949 **Republic of China** incls the 1949 unissued \$20 '**Flying Geese**' issue, and the 1913 London print complete as a Presentation Sheet. Also of note are exceptional **PRC** Liberation Areas (primarily ex-Otstot), the 1969 '**All China is Red**", the '**Mei Lan Fang**' SS, and a FDC stock.

The Hong Kong section is strong, with a nice collection offered intact. The Japan OSS Wartime mini-sheet is offered, as well as a very desirable Japanese reference collection (2,976 items).
