The first was sent on 9 November 1917 from Funchal to Germany via the Prisoner of War Delegations in Madeira and Lisbon, to the Red Cross in Geneva, having the cachets of "COMANDO MILITAR / DA / MADEIRA", and of the Madeira Delegation in violet, plus of the Lisbon Delegation, Geneva Red Cross International Committee, and with a straight line Franc de Port, all in red.

The comprehensive **Ronnie Del Mar** of Early-to-Middle Periods **Worldwide** Postage Stamps Philatelic Estate, covering the QV-era through to the late 1920s, is housed in *Ideal* and *Imperial* albums; the collection is being sold in one-country lots.
