In the Swedish section is an attractive **Ballon Monté** letter sent in 1870 from occupied Paris ==> Sweden (**Starting Price** 3,000 Euros), and a wonderful domestic cover with a **grey** 17 öre stamp (**Starting Price** 7,500 Euros).

The most remarkable items in the Sweden section are the largest known strips of the Swedish 24 öre, 30 öre and 50 öre Type II (1858) Coat-of-Arms issues. These are rare items in their own right, but they are especially interesting because they are parts of the "Mayfair Find" in London, which caused a sensation when it was discovered n 1924.

The story of the find starts in the 1860's when a young collector from a family of means devised a new method of collecting stamps. Rather than trading with friends and dealers in London, he sent money to post offices around the world, asking for stamps in return. His career as a philatelist was short-lived, and the stamps were soon gathering dust in an attic.

More than sixty years later, his relatives found the collection and invited the auctioneer Henry R. Harmer (London) for an valuation. Not only did many of the stamps turn out to be rare and valuable, but several were present in complete sheets of 120 or 240 stamps! While the original collector had paid less than £30 for the entire collection, the value in 1924 was estimated at about £ 10,000.

In the General Foreign section are gems from Sardinia are worth mentioning. There is a neat small cover ==> France with a pair of **black** 5C and one 40 C (**Starting Price** 4,000 Euros), and a very rare cover with a Block-of-4 **olive** 5C (**Starting Price** 8,000 Euros). There are also a large number of better collections, especially those of Schleswig-Holstein, the Cape of Good Hope, and the French and British Colonies.
