Included is the **Sweden "20/Tretio"** Error. These stamps appear to be ordinary 20 öre stamps, but the lettering under number "20" reads "**thirty öre**". When the error was discovered, the stamps were withdrawn, but several hundred were released.

Other highlights listed in the Sweden section include an exceptional "**3 Skilling Banco**", and a very attractive 1 kr Numeral type Block-of-10. An interesting large section includes the postage stamps of **Sweden** exhibiting foreign cancellations. These stamps should have been cancelled in **Sweden**, but left the country uncanceled, and were then cancelled at their foreign destinations.

The **General Foreign** section contains many pleasant surprises, to include **Austria** N° 1 (x6) on cover with "**LANDSKRON**" cds' (Lot N° 725, **Mi** 1X), and the **Austria** 10Kr **blue** with others on C.O.D. stationery and "**WIEN 17.1.79**" cds' (Lot N° 777, **Mi** 35II + 39II + 40II); and the **Western Australia** 2d Swan **muave "Color Error"** used (Lot N° 1067, **SG** 55b)
