British Commonwealth is highlighted by better stunning Great Britain (incl. two nice £5 orange QV, a 1d "VR" Penny Black, and the SG 012S 1882 £1 brown QV "I.R." as a "SPECIMEN"), Australia (incl the 1919 "Ross-Smith" issue), Bahamas, Bermuda, Canada, Cyprus, Hong Kong incl. classic postal history, India (with the

1948 **Gandhi** "**Officials**"), Newfoundland (with the 1919 "**Hawker**" issue on cover, and the 1927 "**De Pinedo**" on cover), high value New Zealand Postal fiscals, North Borneo, Nova Scotia (1859-1860 **Bisect** covers), Rhodesia, Seychelles (with a very nice 1885 Seychelles => France cover), Sudan (incl. a 1884-1940 postal history collection offered intact), and Trinidad (with a "**Lady McLeod**" issue on cover).
